

Bella Academy of Excellence aims for every student to gain more than one vear's growth during the academic year and achieve a Student Growth Percentile of 40 or greater. We also strive for all students who enter below grade level to attain grade level proficiency within three years or less. Those at or above grade level will be challenged to soar beyond expectations. The Renaissance STAR assessment system is used worldwide as a multipurpose tool for screening and progress monitoring, and includes resources for targeting instruction for individual learners. Test indicators measure student learning gains, or academic growth over the course of one

SPONSOR STATEMENT
